VirtueMart v1.1.5.x Payment Module

This payment module provides support for processing Credit Card transactions.

Installation

First, you must work with your web hosting company to install Joomla and the VirtueMart component. After the VirtueMart shopping cart setup is completed, the payment module must be installed.

Unzip the VirtueMart installation package, which contains the component zip file and this installation manual.

Next, you will have to upload the module(s) using the VirtueMart Admin.

Typically, the URL is:

<http://yourserver/virtuemart/administrator/>

After logging in to your VirtueMart Administrative control panel, select [Extensions->Install/Uninstall](#) from the top menu. Next, under [Upload Package File](#), click Browse, and select the component zip, virtuemart-v1.1.5.x_component.zip. Once loaded, Click Upload File & Install.

Configuration

Now that the payment module has been installed on the server, you must configure the setup parameters using the VirtueMart Admin.

First, select [Components -> VirtueMart](#) from the top menu, and under the Store navigation menu on the left, click List Payment Methods. Find and Click on the NMI Gateway Services (Credit Card) module.

Check the box to activate the payment processor.

Under [Payment Method Name](#) - enter the name of the payment method. Try using generic name such as "[Credit Card](#)"; this name will be shown to the buyer.

Under [Code](#) - enter [NMI](#) for the Code option.

Under [Payment Class Name](#) - enter [ps_nmi](#) as the class name.

Under [Payment Method Type](#) - check [Use Payment Processor](#) as the option for payment type.

Under [Accepted Credit Card Types](#), check off the supported Credit Card types.

Finally, click on the [Configuration](#) tab and fill out the form. All necessary instructions are provided on the page.

Lastly, click [Save](#) (in the upper right).

Some VirtueMart versions may have certain Gateway Modules activated by default. Review the list and disable any modules that you will not be using.
